Barb's Dog Rescue determines the criteria for fostering, decides which animals are eligible for foster care and appoints foster caregivers from a pre-approved list of providers. BDR will inform you of any medical treatments to be administered, the anticipated length of the foster care period, the objectives of each particular placement (restoring to health, rearing to adoptable age, socialization, etc) and any other restrictions or expectations.

You will be expected to keep the animal safe and secure, return the dog to Barb's Dog Rescue when requested to do so, and transport the dog to any veterinary appointments. Do not promise the dog to anyone, or imply that you have the authority to approve a potential adoption. Interested potential adopters while dog is in foster care should be directed to contact Barb's Dog Rescue.

Barb's Dog Rescue does not accept people who have been convicted of a violent crime or crimes involving animal cruelty or neglect into our foster program. Students seeking credit for school/community service requirements should speak with the Foster Care Coordinator to discuss the program prior to completing a foster application.

Unless otherwise arranged, the foster parent is responsible for providing all food, toys, bedding and other supplies while it is under their care. The foster parent is responsible for transporting the dog to and from adoption events. Upon return of your foster animal to Barb's Dog Rescue, you will be required to complete a brief questionnaire about your foster dog's behavior & personality.

I have read and understand the statements above. I certify that all the information contained in this application is true and correct. I understand that although Barb's Dog Rescue takes reasonable care to screen animals for foster care placement, it makes no guarantees relating to the dog's health, behavior, or actions. I understand that I receive foster care animals at my own risk and can decline to accept any dog for which BDR has asked me to provide care. I acknowledge that HPAC is not responsible for any property damage or personal injury suffered by me, members of my household, including my own pets, or any third parties during a foster placement, and I assume liability to provide adequate controls to prevent such damage or injury.
